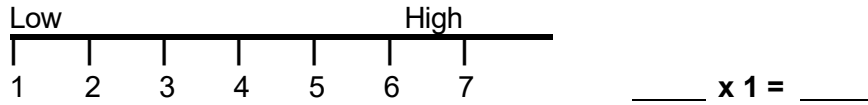

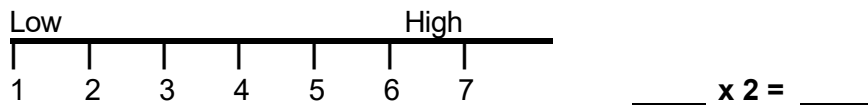

The order of criterion is as follows:

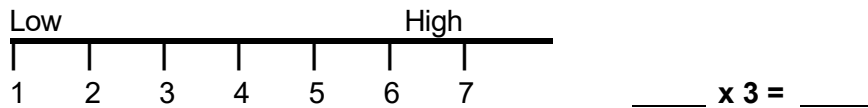
1. **Community Service:** Community and school activities.
